MCTXSheriff Investigating Bank Robbery

On February 13, 2019, at about 8:50 AM, Deputies with the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office were dispatched to the Chase Bank located at 8201 Kuykendahl Road in the Woodlands, Texas, in reference to a Robbery. When Deputies arrived, they learned a light skinned black female with dark black hair, possibly a wig, wearing a grey shirt, black pants, a hat and sunglasses, entered the bank displaying a firearm. The female was dropped off at the bank by a red SUV. The female received an unknown amount of US currency before exiting the bank and leaving the area on foot. The driver of the SUV is a white or Hispanic male, wearing eye glasses. Detectives with Montgomery County Sheriff's Office and FBI are currently investigating and the scene remains active. More information will be given as it becomes available.
